Dear Parents

I am writing to inform you of a change to existing practice regarding changing for PE in school.

The current arrangements involve children changing into their kits for PE and then getting changed back into school uniform afterwards. Following a review of these processes, involving feedback from children, parents and staff, I would like to amend this practice to the following with immediate effect:

Children may now wear their school PE kit into school on the days that they have PE.

Please note that this does not apply where children have a before or after school sports club. In this case children will change in school and will be required to bring their PE kit into school on these days.

We are keen to maintain high standards in terms of uniform. There are two specific areas that we feel we would like to focus on between now and the end of the Summer Term:

- **Standard school shoes should be worn with the school uniform. Trainers/plimsolls can only be worn on PE days.**
- **Standard light blue PE T-shirts should be worn with PE kits please.**

In standardising our approach to improve outcomes for children, we are also trying to make things easier for parents. Please look out for the regular pre-loved uniform sales organised by the FOST team and do let us know if you need any help with sourcing items of uniform.

The [School Website](#) has a lot of information about the correct uniform to be worn as well as sourcing school uniforms; the office is also able to help with any additional questions you may have.

We do hope that this makes things clearer for all involved. We appreciate the feedback we received that enabled us to come to this decision and look forward to moving forward together.
