Relationship Education Sessions

During this term all pupils from the Early Years up to Year 6 will take part in **Relationships and Health Education** lessons (RSHE). In the Summer 2 term, the PSHE scheme, Jigsaw, unit 'Changing Me' is replaced with the Catholic Education Society (CES) scheme 'Journey in Love' (JIL). St Teresa's follows Diocesan policy and the government's statutory requirements for RSHE and JIL provides a programme that will enable our children to develop healthy attitudes toward themselves and others, as well as an understanding of the essential goodness and holiness of creation.

The school, aligned with the teachings of the Church, believes that as parents you are the prime educators of your children. We aim to foster a genuine partnership with you in the education of your children.

We have therefore arranged for a parent's meeting where you will have the opportunity to:

- Have a brief introduction to the scheme
- Have the opportunity to ask questions of the RSHE policy
- Browse through the teaching and learning materials
- Ask any other questions
