Key Skills

Children to show confidence in talking to others about wants, needs and interest.

Children should be beginning to understand why and how questions.

Children should show awareness of rhyming and alliteration.

Children to compare two groups of objects, saying when they have the same number. Beginning to use mathematical names for solid 3D shapes and flat 2D shapes.

Children should be encouraged to talk about some things they have observed such as plants, animals natural and found objects.

Children should also be encouraged to retell events and stories to support their language development.

Books

Reading book day will still take place on a **Friday** so please ensure your child brings their book to school to change it for a new one. This is important in supporting the children's understanding of stories and text. Please encourage your child to look after these books, however if you have lost a book please see a member of Nursery staff. It is also important for you to share your story time on Tapestry. This will be a point of discussion during carpet sessions.

Phonics

Children begin learning phase 1 phonics in Nursery. Phase 1 phonics is **the first stage of the phonics teaching programme**. At this stage, the focus is primarily on developing speaking and listening skills. Speaking and listening are an important set of literacy skills that will create the foundation to a lot of your children's further learning.

Here are the seven aspects that children will be taught during Phase 1:

- Aspect 1: Environmental Sounds.
- Aspect 2: Instrumental Sounds.
- Aspect 3: Body Percussion.
- Aspect 4: Rhythm and Rhyme.
- Aspect 5: Alliteration.
- Aspect 6: Voice Sounds.
- Aspect 7: Oral Blending and Segmenting.

As the weather gets warmer please ensure children are coming to Nursery in appropriate clothing e.g., sun hats, sensible shoes (no open sandals).


Please also apply sun cream before the children come to nursery so they are ready to go to the outside area.


Ambition

Curriculum


This term, we will be continuing with our curriculum-based skills around developing language, mathematical understanding and drawing/writing. This learning takes place every day though group sessions as well as being embedded within the environment. We use stories and context in which to teach the above skills and listed below is our books for the summer term and a brief overview of what we will be covering.

Summer 1

Incy Wincy Spider - The children will continue to develop their listening and recall skills. They will be introduced to why and how questions in relation to the story and whilst exploring the environment. The children will be able to use a wide range of vocabulary, including descriptive words. E.g., the spider is soft and furry. The children will further enhance their feelings and emotions through discussion.



Postman Bear - The children will be intrigued as to what comes next, who is under the flap, behind the door? The children will be encouraged to retell and sequence some of the short story. We will be looking at the friendships within the story and applying this to our core values and further encourage team work. opportunities will be given to look at quantities through baking.




Big Green Crocodile - The children will be able to explore rhyme and alliteration through the different poetry within the book. The children will gain further understanding of the world in which they live through the various poems relating to different environments. They will be given opportunities to discuss the different animals within the poetry and what sounds they make and further investigate the animal's habitat.




Summer 2


Jack and the beanstalk - This story will give the children the opportunity to explore growing and planting. We will use group time to discuss what plants and trees need to help them grow tall, and compare what we need to do to grow up healthy. We will be planting our own seeds and watch how they grow. We will be further developing the children's gross motor skills through a range of climbing and balancing activities, just like Jack.



The Woolly bear Caterpillar - Children will talk about the importance of being kind to one another and explore our similarities and differences through a wide variety of resources. We will be looking at life cycles and growing our own butterflies. The children will continue to grow their vocabulary and apply it in structured play activities.



What the Ladybird Heard - Children will recap their sitting and listening skills and Continue to use rhyming words to further develop their vocabulary. Children will continue to understand the need to respect and care for their natural environment and all living things. The children begin to develop an understanding of honesty and responsibility to support our golden rules and boundaries.
