Dear Parents,

PE Day Information.

Children will have two PE lessons per week taught during curricular time starting this week. Please could you ensure your child wears their school PE kit to school on allocated PE days as listed below.

Extra curricular clubs do not begin until the week beginning 19th September. More details will follow regarding clubs but we wanted to clarify that should your child be enrolled in an after-school club they will need to change into/out of their school uniform (depending on whether the club is before or after school).


This will be an informal session led by teachers, who will share key information with you about the year ahead. This information forms part of the Curriculum booklet that you will also receive shortly.
